The fireworks in the installation, typically symbols of celebration, serve as metaphors for the volatile nature of free expression, embodying both the potential for creation and destruction. Upon entering the exhibition, each visitor receives a lighter and is invited to engage with the fickle tension between risk and restraint.

The work reflects on how far one is willing to push against societal and personal boundaries before encountering the risk of "burning"—whether from external repression or internal self-restraint. The installation sparks a conversation about sacrilege and the invisible forces governing what can be said or left unsaid.
